



Eyebrows Aftercare Instructions

DO

DAY 1 – After the Procedure

- √ **DO** ... Wash your hands before you touch your brows
- √ **DO** ... Gently blot any fluid from oozing brows, to prevent scabbing, every 15', until it has stopped (For Microblading). Once Every Hour (For Shading, Powder brows, Ombre') with a wet cotton pad, squeeze well, before blotting off... FIRST Day Only Use Water Wipes.
brows well, with a clean tissue. √ **DO** ... Dry
- ... Apply a very thin layer (Rice grain size) of "Skin Candy" to the brows. Every time you dab/clean lymph. √ **DO**

DAY 2 – 14 After the Procedure

- √ **DO** ... Gently & Quickly Wash Brows with Mild Soap in the Morning & at Night. Let them air dry 30'
- √ **DO** ... Apply a rice grain size thin layer of "Skin Candy" given to you, 3 times/ Day until all scabs come off
 - √ **DO** ... Day 14 Onward: Apply a rice size Moisturizer 3 times/ Day
- √ **DO** ... Apply sunscreen SPF 30 or higher when going out Especially on a sunny day
- √ **DO** ... Apply Vaseline on brows before you take a Quick Shower. Prevents water from getting brows soaked.
- √ **DO** ... Wash your hair Last
- √ **DO** ... Wear shower cap and cover the brows, to protect them... if showering & are not washing your hair
- √ **DO** ... Dry your brows well from any water moisture. Allow to air dry well before applying moisturizer
- √ **DO** ... Stay out of the sun for at least 2 weeks
- √ **DO** ... Relieve swelling... Wrap a soft ice pack, with a soft cotton fabric... Place on brows
- √ **DO** ... Use a Fresh pillowcase as often as you need to.

DON'T

- X Do Not** ... Sleep on your face/belly for 10 days
- X Do Not** ... Get brows Soaking Wet during the healing process for 14 days
- X Do Not** ... Put Makeup on the brows and no waxing, bleaching, or tinting for 10 days.
- X Do Not** ... Sweat - No heavy sweaty exercise, Saunas, or steamy showers for 14 days.
- X Do Not** ... Scrub, Rub, scratch, or Pick at the Crust that forms. Allow it to flake off, by itself.
- X Do Not** ... Remove crust before is ready, otherwise risking the pigment underneath to be pulled out.
- X Do Not** ... Use Retin-A, Hydroxy, Lactic, Salicylic, Glycolic acid, microdermabrasion in brow area, during/after healing.
- X Do Not** ... Tan for a month and NO direct Sun Exposure as well, after the procedure.
- X Do Not** ... Listen to your friends' aftercare advice or Rush the Healing process.
